
Example 1: Template that is not linked to the hierarchy (hierarchy template box is not checked)



Clicking the 'Hierarchy Template' box would cause a new field to appear where the user selects which level of the hierarchy to apply the template to. Options would be University, School/College, or Department. Note that these choices should probably only be available to users who have access to them, so only a super eval admin would see all three choices.

Selecting School/College or Department would cause another field to appear which would contain the appropriate options based on the choice made on the previous field. These choices would be based on the hierarchy setup.





This wireframe shows one possible way that an evaluation could be flagged as an eval which should have the hierarchy applied to it. The Choose Template area would only show templates that the user has access to.



It also shows the template that was selected in the first step of adding an evaluation for the Department-level hierarchy. Users could view a preview, which would pull all the questions from each level together into one eval.



This page can remain as is, however, here are some features that could make it more user-friendly:

- limit the selection to only the classes that the user has permission to (based on the Eval Admin interface)
- make the titles sortable
- show if the class is a lecture, lab, discussion, etc (not sure if Sakai would even have this data to display)
