

Requirements

Overview

Support instructor selecting an individual participant and seeing all posts from all forums and topics. Advanced view could include date restrictions. Resulting view would be in a printer-friendly format and indicate forum and topic as well as provide a hyperlink into the discussion context.

Use Cases

- 1) An instructor is grading his students on participation and would like to see not only how many forum messages the student sent, but the content that the student provided in the forum messages in order to get an accurate picture of the student's participation. The instructor would also like to be able to print the student's message content for off-line viewing.
- 2) An instructor is viewing an individual student's post and wants to be able to read that post in the context of the discussion at hand.

- To view all messages authored by the student in a print-friendly format, the instructor must select 'Show Full Text for All'. The system then displays all messages authored by the student in a thickbox, as shown on the Full Text for All Authored screen (FTAA-1).
- If the instructor selects 'Show Full Text for All', all messages that have not been read by the instructor will be marked as read for the instructor, for the purpose of forum statistics.
- The Topic Title, Date, and Subject columns are now sortable.
- By default, the Messages Authored and Messages Read lists are sorted in descending order by date.
- Clicking the Date column header will sort the messages in ascending order by date.
- Clicking the Topic Title column header will first sort the messages in ascending alphanumeric order. Clicking the Topic Title column header again will sort the messages in descending alphanumeric order.
- Clicking the Subject column header will first sort the messages in ascending alphanumeric order. Clicking the Subject column header again will sort the messages in descending alphanumeric order.
- Headers have changed from 'Forum Authored' and 'Forum Read' to 'Messages Authored' and 'Messages Read'.
- To view an individual message in the context of the entire topic, the instructor will click the '[display in thread]' link. The system will then display the message that was authored by the student in the context of the entire topic in a thickbox, as shown on the Full Text for All in Topic screen (FTAT-1).
- To view the content of an individual message, the instructor will select the Subject link for the message that he wishes to view. The system will then display the selected message in a thickbox, as shown on the Full Text for Individual Authored screen (FTIA-1).
